## **Water Contractor Coordination Calls**

Purpose: Provide a regular forum for the exchange of information and development of action items as related to situational awareness, threats to facilities and infrastructure, and the impact on the public.

- Continuation of a productive process established during wildfires and PSPS events
- Reinforced the value and need for establishing Emergency Training & Coordination subcommittee
- Strengthened communications channels among participants



### After Action Review at Sonoma Water

A comprehensive, multiphased review process encompassing both the COVID-19 and LNU Wildfire Response and consisting of online surveys and virtual discussions. Includes feedback from:

- All Sonoma Water Employees
- Sonoma Water's EOC
- Water Contractors

## Water Contractor Survey Focus Areas

- Effectiveness of coordination calls for sharing current information, best practices, and risk analysis
- Frequency and quality of communication
- Strengths and weaknesses
- Mitigation action recommendations



## Findings from the Water Contractors AAR Survey

#### To Continue:

 Holding regular meetings during emergency incidents focused on situational awareness, threats to facilities and infrastructure, mutual aid, and public impact.



#### To Improve Upon:

- In the regular meetings, include better communication on risk analysis & capacity/demand issues.
- Focus on mitigation: system
  redundancies (generators, fuel, pumps,
  storage, etc.), vegetation clearing, fire
  vulnerability assessments, real time
  demand and production adjustments,
  improved weather
  reporting, and preparation of
  facilities/personnel for power
  outages (PSPS).
- Establish a training and exercise program with the Water Contractors (Current action item in the Emergency Training & Coordination Subcommittee)
- Develop a incident-based conservation messaging plan (Current action item in the Emergency Training & Coordination Subcommittee)
