


## Purpose of the HMP

- Identify risks and vulnerabilities for Sonoma County and its jurisdictions
- Establish mitigation goals and strategies to reduce long-term risk
- Ensure eligibility for federal and state disaster assistance

- Maintained Local Hazard
   Mitigation Plans (LHMP) for
   Sonoma Water, SVCSD, and
   RRCSD (slowly combining
   into one LHMP for all)
- Sonoma Water LHMP approved in 2024
- MJHMP provided an opportunity to maintain this tool without the administrative burden
- Led by Sonoma County
   Department of Emergency
   Management


