- Treat and beneficially reuse 17 million gallons of recycled water per day






Recycled Water

20% community-wide reduction and restriction on water-use

Community call to action to adopt water-conserving behaviors



Restrictions on Water Use

Water waste prohibited

Irrigation limited to 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Shut-off nozzles required for all hoses


Washing down hard surfaces is prohibited

Pressure washing is prohibited, unless a variance is obtained

Restaurants - only serve water upon request

Hotels/lodging - provide linens only upon request











