Background and Purpose

- 2008 NMFS Biological Opinion (BO) with Reasonable and Prudent Alternative (15-year BO; expiration in Sept. 2023)
 - CESA Consistency Determination with CDFW
- BA being prepared for reinitiation of consultation with NMFS under Federal Endangered Species Act (FESA)
 - Central California Coast Steelhead (threatened)
 - Central California Coast Coho Salmon (endangered)
 - California Coastal Chinook Salmon (threatened)
 - Bay-Delta Longfin Smelt DPS (USFWS, proposed endangered)
- BA will also evaluate effects on essential fish habitat (EFH) as required by Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act
 - Pacific Salmon Fishery Management Plan (FMP), Coastal Pelagics FMP, and Pacific Groundfish FMP
- BA serves as basis for California ESA (CESA) and MPA coverage with CDFW
 - Central California Coast Coho Salmon (CESA, endangered)
 - Longfin Smelt (CESA, threatened)
 - Marine Protected Areas (MPA)

Project Elements

- Reservoir Operations Coyote Valley Dam (CVD) and Warm Springs Dam (WSD)
 - Deviations to the WCM with FIRO procedures
 - Interim Petition(s) followed by Fish Habitat Flows and Water Rights Project
- Dry Creek Habitat Enhancements
- Channel Maintenance Actions
 - Dry Creek (maintenance of facilities associated with WSD operations)
- Central Sonoma Watershed Project and associated flood control facilities operations
- Russian River Estuary Management
- Monitoring of Salmonids in the Russian River and Dry Creek
- Interrelated and Interdependent Actions
 - SW water supply operations, Mirabel and Wohler facilities
- Hatchery Operations (maintenance)
 - Coho Hatchery and Genetic Management Program
 - Steelhead Hatchery and Genetic Management Program

Approach and Process

- Agency kick-off April 28, 2021
 - Sonoma Water, Corps, NMFS, CDFW
- Monthly Management Team meetings
 - Sonoma Water, Corps
- Focused Sub-group meetings
 - 9 Environmental Baseline meetings
 - 7 Proposed Action meetings
- CESA-focused meetings with CDFW
- Draft BA submittal and review (NMFS and CDFW, December, 2022)
 - Focus area meetings and workshops (November 2022 through February 2023)
 - Written comments
- Submittal of BA by the Corps (February 2023)

NMFS and CDFW comments on December 2022 Draft BA

- Comments were provided by NMFS on entire document and specific project elements
 - Discussed in focused project element meetings and workshops

General comments included the following:

- Add detail to Proposed Action including reporting requirements, timelines, and process for agency review/coordination
 - Incorporate descriptions of the current status of all RPAs and RPMs included in the 2008 Biological Opinion
- Clarify environmental baseline to facilitate effects analysis
- Expand analysis of effects on species and critical habitat:
 - Focus on both life-stage and population-level effects
 - Increase geographic specificity within watershed
 - Incorporate best available science where applicable

- Complete Agency Review Draft BA
 - Submittal December 2022 (NMFS and CDFW)
 - Focus meetings and workshops (January February 2023)
- Corps submittal of revised BA (February 2023)
 - NMFS comment letter; requesting additional information
- Revising draft BA (addressing NMFS and CDFW comments)
 - Ongoing, summer 2023
- Support Sonoma Water and Corps (in consultation with NMFS and CDFW) to complete BO and obtain CESA coverage
