Improving stream habitats while providing flood protection for our community

This summer and fall, Sonoma Water will be conducting several creek projects as part of the Stream Maintenance Program in Sonoma County. Activities occur mainly along urban streams to provide flood protection and restore habitats, and include managing vegetation, clearing sediment and garbage, repairing eroded banks, and planting native trees.
