PRIORITIES**

Local Water Priorities – Rohnert Park

- We'd like to highlight the need for increased federal investment in local and regional water storage across the watershed, including funding for feasibility studies so smaller jurisdictions can evaluate and advance viable storage projects.
- We're also seeing growing challenges from new water quality regulations and emerging contaminants. For smaller communities with limited staff and budgets, new compliance requirements really need to be paired with funding and technical assistance.
- Overall, building additional storage capacity and supporting smaller jurisdictions will be key to maintaining long-term water supply reliability for our region.

Prop 4 Funding Request – Rohnert Park

- We're seeking Proposition 4 funding for three priority projects that improve climate resilience, water reliability, and active transportation in our community.
- The first would complete a bike and pedestrian trail connection to Crane Creek Regional Park, expanding regional trail access and reducing vehicle trips.
- The second is a seismic retrofit of key water tanks and municipal wells to ensure the City can maintain potable water service after a major earthquake.
- The third is a citywide stormwater hydraulic analysis to address recurring flooding and develop long-term, climate-resilient drainage solutions.

Together, these projects help strengthen regional infrastructure, protect public health, and improve climate resilience for our community.
