## **Meeting Agenda:**

- **1. Opening/Introductions.** Meeting commenced at 1:02 p.m. Chair Orrett introduced the attending (present) Committee members.

- **4. 2023 Sonoma Water Local Hazard Mitigation Plan (LHMP) Update.** Informational presentation was given by Parastou Hooshialsadat regarding Sonoma Water's LHMP. The presentation summarized the LHMP history, purpose and content; and



the status of the 2018 LHMP implementation. The presentation also outlined the 2023 LHMP update, timeline, and upcoming opportunities for stakeholder and public participation.

- **5. Stream Maintenance Program Update.** Informational presentation was given by Chase Takajo summarizing Sonoma Water's sediment removal, vegetation management, and trash cleanup activities conducted along flood control channels and streams in 2022. An overview of foreseen SMP items that will be upcoming/ongoing in 2023, such as the ongoing USACE permit renewal and effort to find suitable sediment disposal locations, was also given.
- 6. Fiscal Year 2023/24 Flood Control Budget. Chase Takajo and Carlos Diaz presented and described the recommended budget for the Committee's review and consideration. Action: The Committee approved the recommended budget as submitted.
