## Climate Change & Resilience in the North Bay

In this 5-day workshop, participants will take a close look at five local organizations addressing climate change to help create a more resilient Sonoma County.

*Who:* Middle and high school teachers in Sonoma County

*When:* July 18-22, 2022; 9:00 am to 5:00 pm

*Where:* Several locations within Sonoma County

*Stipend:* 15-20 teachers will earn \$750 for 5 days of training, lesson creation, and evaluation. An additional \$250 will be provided for implementation of lessons. CEU credits available

- Fire ecology and land stewardship informed with principles of Traditional Ecological Knowledge (TEK)
- Securing our water resources in a changing climate
- Impacts of climate change on the diverse ecosystems of the Sonoma Coast
- Electricity and our renewable energy future
- How to talk about climate change
- Hands-on solution-focused projects at school

- Tour locations selected by five organizations: Daily Acts, Pepperwood, Sonoma Water, Sonoma County Regional Parks, and Sonoma Clean Power
- Choose from kayaking or bird walking at Doran Beach
- Work with a credentialed educator to turn workshop experiences into curriculum aligned with NGSS
